### GUIDELINES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

- The Guitar Society reserves the right to cancel any competition division and return student entries and fees if insufficient entries are received.
  - Entries received after 11:59pm EST February 15, 2021 will not be accepted.
  - Please only send AUDIO FILES for preliminary round.
  - Semi-finals will be Video & Audio. The same video files will also be used in the Final Round and will be broadcast during the 2021 PCGS Annual Classical Guitar Festival.
- The same repertoire must be performed in the Preliminary, Semifinal, and Final Rounds.
- Videos should be filmed with one still camera shot showing the competitor's instrument and hands.
- Editing of recorded entries is not permitted and will be sufficient reason for disqualification.
- Semifinalists will be selected by March 15, 2021.
- Finalists will be announced by April 1, 2021.
